Dear Parents and Carers

Sports Day will soon be upon us so I am writing to confirm arrangements for the day on **Wednesday 28th June.** Hopefully we will have some good weather and will be able to enjoy some sunshine!

Key Stage 1 (Years 1 and 2)

Races will begin at 9.30am and you are welcome to wait on the field after dropping your child in their class. We would ask that you please make sure that your child has a bottle of water and a sunhat with them at the start of the day rather than giving it to them on the field. Please also make sure your child is wearing sun cream. In the interests of keeping all of our children safe, please stay on the parents side of the running track. We appreciate that some children become excited when they see their parents but the staff know how to deal with this and can then make sure that the children are ready for their races. Thank you for your help with this.

Early Years (Nursery and Reception)

Sports Day will begin at 1.30pm and you are welcome to take a seat on the field from 1pm. Please make sure that water bottles and sunhats are in school at the start of the day, and that your child is wearing sun cream. As with the morning races, please stay on the parents side of the running track so that staff know where all of the children are and can make sure that the children are ready for their races. Your help with this is much appreciated.

If your child attends our morning nursery session and would like to partake in the races, they must stay with you on the field until their race is called as our nursery staff will be supervising the children who come to our afternoon session.

PE Kits

Children need to come to school in their school uniform and will change into their PE kits - all children need their PE kit in school on this day. As the children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 will be collecting points for their school team, it would be wonderful if your child could bring a tshirt in the colour of their team – green, red, blue or yellow. If your child is unsure of which team they are in, please ask your child's class teacher. The children in our nursery may come to nursery already dressed in suitable clothing – shorts, tshirt, trainers etc.

In the event of bad weather, we will endeavour to let you know as soon as possible if we need to cancel. Fingers crossed for sunshine!
