What is the Early Years Foundation Stage?

- The Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) is the stage of education for children from **birth** to the **end of the Reception year**.
- It is based on the recognition that children learn best through **play and active learning**.
- We plan our curriculum alongside guidance from the non-statutory document **‘Development Matters’**



There are 3 **Prime Areas** of learning and 4 **Specific Areas**.

The Prime Areas work together and move through to support development in all other areas. The Specific Areas include essential skills and knowledge for children to participate successfully in society.

1. **Communication and Language**
2. **Personal, Social and Emotional Development**
3. **Physical Development**
4. **Literacy**
5. **Mathematics**
6. **Understanding the World**
7. **Expressive Arts and Design**



Termly Topics

The children will enjoy learning within the following topics each term. We will encourage our Nursery children to explore and extend their experiences at home through our 'Friday Challenges'. Children access learning through 'continuous provision'.

Focused Tasks and Friday Challenges

Throughout the week, your child will take part in a weekly '**Focused Task**' which will explore an area of learning from the Early Years Foundation Stage. The Nursery team will share observations for this learning challenge using Tapestry.



Each week a '**Friday Challenge**' will be set to complete over the weekend. This will have a different focus each week and will consolidate learning in Nursery during that week. Please do share your child's observations of this on Tapestry.



Tapestry

We use Tapestry to record photos and videos of your child's learning throughout their time in Reception.

How Tapestry works:

- * Provide a 'learning journey' of your child's time in Reception
- * Instantly share photos, videos and special memories
- * Parents and family members can contribute photo's and achievements from home
- * Look out for invitations via email – this can often be sent to 'junk mail'.



Parklands Person

Our ethos is centred around the aim of ensuring that every child becomes a Parklands Person.

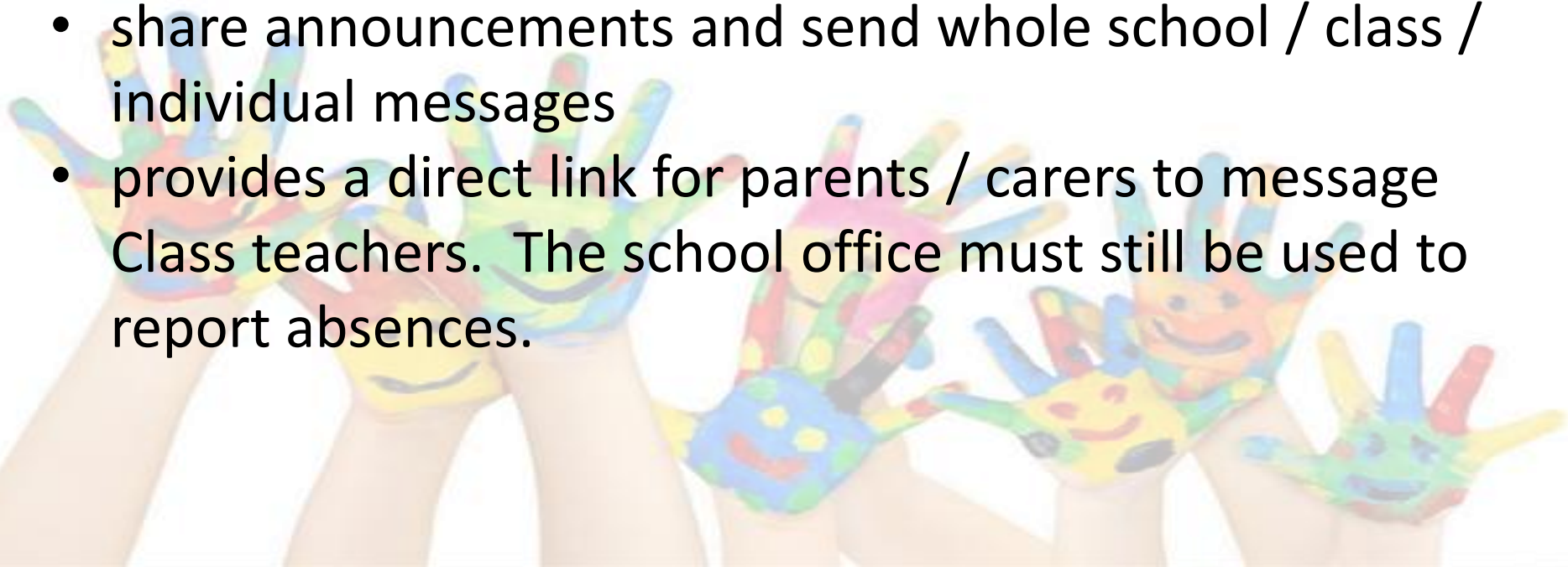
ClassDojo



From September, we have used Class Dojo as a way to communicate with our parents and carers.

Class Dojo is used to:

- keep our families informed of what is happening in school through stories and photos
- share announcements and send whole school / class / individual messages
- provides a direct link for parents / carers to message Class teachers. The school office must still be used to report absences.



Weekly Baking sessions

This year, all of our children have enjoyed taking part in our weekly baking sessions. The sessions are timetabled to ensure that all children bake throughout the week.

- Annual Scootathon



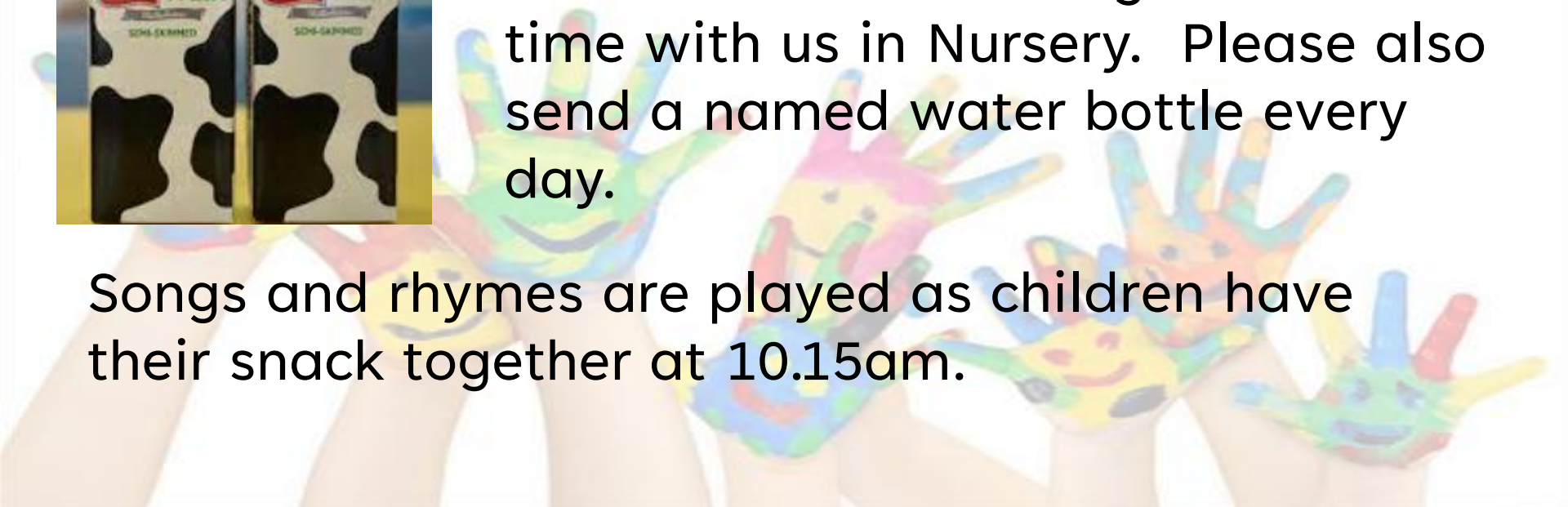
Snack time

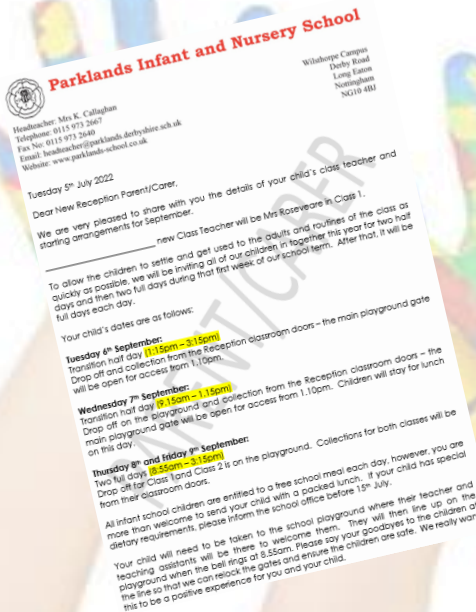
