Area of Need:		
Cognition and Learning		
Challenges	Provision for SEND pupils	
Children may struggle with the conceptual understanding of chronology.	Use simplified visual prompts/activities to support their understanding.	
Low attainment in English/Maths may prevent the child from accessing the activities.	Use dual coded resources. Provide additional adult support. Knowledge organisers to have age appropriate images and level of text. Where possible, text to be read aloud to pupils by adult or peer helpers. Language rich environment and lessons with lots of recapping.

Area of Need:		
Social, Emotional & Mental Health		
Challenges	Provision for SEND pupils	
Children may have low self-esteem,	Clear, simple instructions.	
lack confidence or be disparaging	Encouragement and praise.	
causing them to withdraw or become frustrated.	Scaffolding to allow for small steps of success.	
Children may find the lesson content upsetting or triggering	Ensure content is appropriate for the children in the class e.g. less focussed on the death aspect if bereavement is present.	

Area of Need:		
Physical & Sensory		
Challenges	Provision for SEND pupils	
Children may have sensory difficulties which makes handling artefacts difficult.	Provide photographs/videos of the artefact being handled. Allow children to choose whether they touch them. Describe materials to the child or allow them to work with a peer helper and give them the role of observer.	
School trips to museums/places of historical significance may be difficult.	Ensure that trips are accessible and suitable for all children.
