children understand why it is like that, and can contrast where they live with more distant localities, in this country and abroad. This understanding ensures children are aware of the cultural traditions associated with the place they are studying, as well as our own multicultural society.

Studying their local area,

Exploring current envirolmrntal issues, developing a moral understanding. Issues are explored through fun decisionmaking activities, where children understand the views held by society, and by various groups within society, and will develop their own attitudes and values in relation to these.

Looking at different places and introduced to their customs and traditions allowing pupils to develop their humility and an understanding of the world as a global community.

> Looking at how different cultures and beliefs can impact on the environment and human issues.

SMSC in Geography

Developing children's spiritual development. By studying people; where they live and our relationship with the environment. This provides children with the opportunities to reflect on their own values and beliefs and those of others.
