

Autumn One homework

Your child will be bringing home a green homework book. They may complete the following activities in it, or they can complete homework using any method you choose at home- you can always take a photograph and message us through ClassDojo of any work completed (spellings practised on a dry-wipe board, a painting etc). Homework can be handed in whenever you choose and looked at, at any point this half term.

Reading:

Please read your child's reading book as often as possible. We are continuing with our 'Rainbow Readers' this year- we cannot stress the importance of reading with your child and the benefits this brings to all areas of the curriculum! Your child will also bring home a sheet containing the words they need to practise reading for their current Read, Write, Inc group for phonics.

Spellings:

our, house, school, friend, where, there, were, here, come, some.

If your child is able to spell them, can they write sentences containing these words?

Maths: Children have been practising the place value of 2-digit numbers. For example- they are learning that '23' is $20 + 3$ and they have been using resources to represent this- the children will recognise the apparatus (dienes rods and tens and ones counters) used on the sheet.

History: Tell a grown up or produce a piece of work about Rosa Parks.
(Children will learn about Rosa Parks the week commencing 15th September).
